

## ASC POLICY 3.8

### TEACHERS PROHIBITED FROM REGISTRATION AS SCHOLARSHIP PLAN SALESPERSONS

1. In this policy the word “teacher” has the same meaning as in the Teaching Profession Act which defines "teacher" as a person holding a permanent or temporary certificate of qualification as a teacher issued by the Minister under the Department of Education Act.
2. Because teachers are in a position of authority in relation to students and their parents, and because there would be a public perception that scholarship plans sold by a teacher may have the sanction of a school, a school board, school administrators or a teachers professional association, and because a teacher would be selling only a single product and therefore might be subject to a bias, the Commission believes that it is contrary to the public interest to register teachers in this category of registration.
3. Accordingly,
  - 3.1 no teacher employed full-time or part-time, in any school system, up to and including high school, whether on sabbatical or between positions, or
  - 3.2 no teacher employed by the Alberta Teachers Associationshall be registered as a scholarship plan salesperson.
